MEDIA & TECH LUNCH

On Thursday 1st October, the Club will host an address from Steve Oliver, the CEO and Founder of musicMagpie. Founded in 2007 the company has become a household name after it turned the business of reselling CD's, DVDs and games into an industrial scale operation. The business has evolved from selling physical media to reselling all forms of consumer technology. The figures speak for themselves not only being the UK leading consumer technology business in the UK, but it is now the biggest reseller of physical media and consumer technology in the world. The group employs 750 people, exports to 140 countries around the world and boasts an annual turnover of over £120m. It also became the first business in the world to get more than five million positive reviews on eBay and has over 100,000 five-star ratings on Trustpilot with more than six million happy customers.

In the US, the company operates as Decluttr and uses exactly the same business model as in the UK. Customers trade in their unwanted tech and media to Decluttr. These items are then refurbished and listed for sale on the Decluttr website, as well as the Amazon and eBay marketplaces. Decluttr has experienced significant growth. It has more than doubled its revenues in the last 12 months to a run rate in excess of \$50m, with the consumer electronics category climbing to over 50% of total revenue for the first time.

Find out what's next for this remarkable business. As this is likely to be an exceedingly popular event, we recommend that you book your places as early as possible.

The event format is simple, Members and their Guests will be presented with two stories regarding a wine; their job is to guess which of our two eminent sommeliers' is telling the truth and who is telling a fib, and if you've met them both you know this is a near impossible task as both have a great knowledge of oenology in addition to being able to spin a yarn.

The event takes place early in the month on Thursday 17th and as it's also Tony Seymour's fortieth birthday plenty of celebrating will take place. It's guaranteed to be an extremely exciting and fun night and following the sell out in August Members are encouraged to book their places early.


